CONTINUES SUPPORT TO UKRAINIAN CITIZENS IN GEORGIA

The international humanitarian organization CARE Caucasus has been responding to the humanitarian crisis since the first weeks of the war in Ukraine. CARE identified the needs and priorities of refugees, developed and delivered a multi-purpose cash assistance program to vulnerable groups, distributed food and hygiene items, and provided legal and protection advice primarily to support women and children.

The continuation of the support program is the expansion of existing services and assistance in the socio-economic integration of Ukrainians in Georgia. CARE will support local and Ukrainian civil society and women's and youth initiatives. The project will also focus on the economic recovery of refugees, namely access to employment opportunities through training and support for start-up business ideas and initiatives.

In particular, the project includes:

- Financial support to those individuals who have not received cash assistance from other organizations;
- Support of public organizations and initiative groups working with Ukrainian refugees;
- Support of pilot business initiatives of Ukrainian citizens through initial financing and consulting;
- Provision of basic life-necessary assistance, especially to women, children and the elderly, namely the distribution of food and hygiene kits;
- Dissemination of information about existing assistance services in Georgia.
